World Day of Refugees and Migrants - January 15 - 2017

"Whoever receives one such child in my name receives me; and whoever receives me, receives not me but him who sent me" (*Mk* 9:37; *Mt* 18:5; *Lk* 9:48; *Jn* 13:20).

The theme chosen by Pope Francis for the upcoming World Day of Migrants and Refugees is "Child Migrants, the Vulnerable and the Voiceless" Migrant children, the most vulnerable and fragile victims of war and persecution, will be at the heart of the Catholic Church's annual day of reflection and prayer on the situation of migrants and refugees.

As Christians, we are called to reach out to and pray for all migrants to emphasize the unity of the human family and the values of acceptance, hospitality and love of neighbour. As we prepare to celebrate the 103rd World Day of Migrants and Refugees, on Sunday, 15 January 2017, it is important that we come together to remember and pray for the tens of thousands of children who migrate alone, unaccompanied, to escape poverty and violence. Children are the most vulnerable and hardest hit among the world's migrants and require special protection, Pope Francis said. The Pope made these comments in a message on the theme of 'Child Migrants, the Vulnerable and the Voiceless' for the World Day for Migrants and Refugees 2017. In his message, the Pope called for greater protection and integration of immigrants and refugees who are minors, especially those who are unaccompanied.
