Wedding at Cana

In his Gospel, John describes the action by Jesus at Cana as a "sign" that reveals his glory. Jesus is made manifest, and so people come to believe. It is what happened to the Magi; it is what happened to the crowds gathered at the Jordan; it is what happened to the disciples who were with him at the wedding feast. The wonder of God's glory is not reserved to spectacular miracles that take place only at rare intervals. Seeing the manifestation of God's action each day is the sign of one who believes that the Word is made flesh and dwells among us.

Sunday of the Word of God- 23 January 2022

In his Apostolic Letter of 30 September 2019, Aperuitillis Pope Francis established that the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time is to be the Sunday of the Word of God. A day dedicated to the Bible will help the church "experience anew how the risen Lord opens up for us the treasury of his Word and enables us to proclaim its unfathomable riches before the world," the pope said in the document establishing the special Sunday observance.
