

### MISSION CO-OP APPEAL

On August 11 & 12 at all masses, Rev. Msgr. Eugene Pereira will be speaking about the works and the needs of the Latin Archdiocese of Trivandrum in India. Trivandrum has about 270,000 Catholics. 90% of the people are traditional fishermen who depend on fishing for their livelihood and 10% are farm workers who are recent converts from low caste Hindus. Unemployment and poverty are most rampant in this community. The Archdiocese depends on outside assistance to support its clergy, seminarians, Catechists and to continue its developmental programs for the Community. However, on November 30, 2017 several coastal villages of the Archdiocese were hit by Cyclone "Ockhi". More than 289 young fishermen got drowned in the sea while doing deep sea fishing. There is so much sadness and devastation in their villages. Many young catholic families lost their men and everything they had owned. We are looking for emergency assistance to help the children especially, with food, clothing and shelter.

## HIROSHIMA/NAGASAKI COMMEMORATION DAY – AUGUST 6, 2019

Each year in Toronto, a coalition of groups organizes a very meaningful ceremony at the Peace Garden at City Hall to remember the horrendous bombing of Hiroshima and Nagasaki on August 6 and 9, 1945, to look at the continued existence of over 15,000 nuclear weapons in the world today, at the passionate efforts to eliminate such weapons, and to pray for peace. Toronto is privileged to have in our midst, one of the few remaining Hibakusha (original survivors of the bombing of Hiroshima), Setsuko Thurlow, who has given most of her life to calling on the world to eliminate nuclear weapons, and who, along with the organization, ICAN, received the 2017 Nobel Peace Prize... This year, the keynote speaker, Ray Acheson, a young peace activist who was closely involved with ICAN, the organization behind the UN Treaty for the Prohibition of **Nuclear Weapons.** 

The Vatican was one of the first states to sign and ratify this UN Treaty which gives hope to the world. As Christians, Jesus calls us to turn from violence of all kinds, particularly of the magnitude of nuclear destruction of the world. You are invited to participate in this ceremony on Tuesday, August 6, 6:30 p.m. at the Peace Garden at City Hall. See the flyer at the back of the Church. If you come a bit earlier, you can make a Peace Lantern for the traditional floating of Lanterns in the pool at City Hall.
