Imagine a father and teenage son who rarely speak. They are strangers living under the same roof. For years the father has tried to restore the relationship but the son is always cold, distant and non-responsive. The sad father longs for things to be the way they used to be.

For some of us, unfortunately, our relationship with God is not so different. This is because we don't pray. Like the son, we sometimes ignore our heavenly father's calls to spend that quality time with him.

Never giving up hope, the father again asks his son if he wants to play catch. Astonishingly, the son agrees. At first it is a bit awkward, but before long they are laughing and really connecting. Afterwards, the son says, "Dad, this was so much fun. We need to do this more often." Unbeknownst to him, his father is holding back tears.

In today's gospel, Jesus invites us to connect (or reconnect) with our heavenly father through prayer. No matter how distant we have been or how far away we have turned, God will rejoice if we respond to his call to spend time with him. He knocks on the door of our hearts every day and waits. Today is the time to let him in. Today is the time to pray!
