The woman in today's Gospel comes with humility to Jesus. She knows that she has sinned. And she wants to experience transformation and new life. She realizes that she cannot do it alone anymore. She comes before Jesus acknowledging her sinfulness with the faith and hope that Jesus can forgive her sins, transform her life and give her an opportunity for a new beginning. St. Paul also talks about how God's grace transformed him from a persecutor of the church to an apostle of Christ.

Thus the readings drive us to the heart of Christian faith and the ultimate basis for our hope. The God we adore, the God revealed to us in Jesus, is a God of unconditional compassion and love. A God, who forgives without limit. A God, who loves us in spite of our sinfulness. The Christian life is marked not just by sinful stumbling along the way but by getting up, dusting ourselves off and walking home to Christ as often as we need to repent. And when we walk into the house to encounter Jesus, we receive the same acceptance that the woman did: a welcome home.
