## Mass Intentions

*Rosary at 11:50 a.m.*

In the scripture passages for this weekend we see Elijah and Jesus respond with great compassion to a widow suffering the loss of a child. And in both accounts what is revealed to us is the presence of God who stands by the widow in each of these stories. In both accounts God does not abandon those who grieve and are suffering. Rather, God breathes new life into the moment and brings the gift of hope to those who mourn.

What these two stories tell us is that God does not abandon us no matter how difficult the situation is. God always moves into our lives at moments of greatest pain and difficulty. When all our resources are totally gone, God's resources are just beginning.

The lesson of today is that we should never think that God's only Son came to live among us when everything was going well. Rather, God's only Son, Jesus Christ, came to us so that he might journey with us and sometimes even carry us when life seems difficult and our hearts are heavy. For what is important is the knowledge that God acts in the darkest moments of our lives and blesses our hearts with the gift of hope. For God always is always acting on our behalf.
