PASTOR'S PEN



On our journey with those to be baptized at the Easter Vigil, we celebrate today the third scrutiny. So, let's enter with those to be baptized, the scripture story for the third scrutiny – the raising of Lazarus. The words of Martha to Jesus: "Lord, if you had been here my brother would not have died", have probably been uttered by many people when faced with the death of a loved one. And we would want nothing more than what Jesus did for Lazarus – bring our loved one back to earthly life! Jesus can and does bring Lazarus back to earthly life, but that is not his purpose in having come to this world.

While Jesus brought Lazarus back to natural life, obviously Lazarus at some point died again. Jesus came to give life that cannot be touched by death, so that those who believe in him will never die. It is in baptism that we are given that life – a life that will never end. We began Lent with the reminder that we will return to dust. We end at Easter with the proclamation of new life!
