

Today's Gospel passage immediately follows St. John the Evangelist's account of Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem, just days before His Passion and Death. Even among His closest disciples, very few had any idea of what Jesus would soon suffer. So, when some Greeks ask to see Jesus, it's telling that He answers that the "Hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified."

The Greeks might have been impressed, thinking that they'd found this Jesus at just the right time: the hour of His glory! If Peter, James and John were there to hear Jesus' answer, they might have thought that Jesus was referring to the fulfillment of the transfiguration that they'd seen on the mountain. However, on the mount of Calvary another type of glorification was to occur.

The glory of the Cross is the glory of the grain of wheat falling to the ground and dying. The glory of the Cross lies in loss of self for the sake of an abundance for others. The glory of Jesus' Cross lies in loss of self not for oneself, nor even only for God, but also for all those whom God loves, which is all peoples. The hour has come for each of us to enter into Jesus' glory, the glory of the Cross.


