The readings for this Sunday center on the power of the Holy Spirit and the Hope which the Spirit inspires in the followers of Jesus.

Christian life can be very daunting. Because of that we can become discouraged, not only by our own weaknesses but by the many ways in which the world around us does not cooperate with our good intentions. That is why today's Gospel is so important. Taking us back into the pre-Resurrection part of the story, Jesus' farewell address at the Last Supper shows just how much the disciples were clinging to Jesus' human presence. They expected him to do everything for them, to protect them from enemies, doubt, uncertainty, risk. They panicked at the very suggestion that he would be leaving them to face their own responsibilities.

The promise of Jesus is that with his necessary departure the Father will give another to stand beside us. That promise is identified with the commitment of Jesus to return to us and be with us again in a new way. That new presence of Jesus and the indwelling of the Spirit of truth are mentioned interchangeably. Let us pray in these pre-Pentecost days for the sending of the Spirit of God, the Spirit of Christ, to be our Advocate.
