### Pope Francis offers encouragement to Ontario's bishops in their fight for conscience rights for health care workers.

Conscience rights was a key topic among several talking points raised by the 21 Ontario bishops when they met with the Pope during their *ad limina* visit to the Vatican April 25.Bishop Douglas Crosby, president of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops, said the group expressed its concerns about proposed Ontario legislation that offers no protection for the right of doctors and other health care workers to conscientiously object to participating directly or indirectly in helping a patient die.

Pope Francis, the bishop said, "agreed with our concern" and encouraged the bishops in their fight. Toronto's Cardinal Thomas Collins described the conscience provisions surrounding legalized euthanasia as "the most urgent issue we are dealing with." Among other matters discussed during the meeting were the Canadian Catholic Church's relations with indigenous communities, immigration and medically assisted suicide in Canada.
