Christ the Servant-King

As our liturgical year draws to a close, we celebrate Jesus as King. Whenever people tried to project their own hopes for a political-military Messiah onto Jesus, he ran as far away as possible! Before Pilate, Jesus does not explicitly refuse the title of King, but he insists that his kingdom is "not of this world."

What kind of king is Jesus? Jesus is the *servant-king*. He models authority by **humble service**: kneeling before his disciples and washing their feet, embracing his passion and death with **generous** love for all of humanity. Religious art often depicts Christ as Ruler of the Universe, enthroned in glory; but the most enduring and central icon of Christ the King remains the **Crucifix**. Jesus' only crown is a crown of thorns; his only power, fidelity to the mission entrusted to him by his Father: "to bear witness to the truth."

And what is this truth? That authority is not about power, control, and self-interest, but about loving service of others. The way of self-giving, suffering love *is* the way of God. In bearing witness to this central truth, Jesus sets us free from the illusions of wealth, fame and power that bind us.


