Christ - Like Humility

Christ was a servant for our sake. He humbled himself, even to death on a cross. What is true Christ-like humility? Humility is self-knowledge, seeing ourselves in reality as God sees us. We are humble when we live in the face of the fact that we are both dependent and interdependent. The humble do not trust in themselves, but trust in God and in the power of His love and saving grace. True humility is living in reality, in joy and simplicity.

Jesus closes this week's passage with strong words which reiterate the crux of His message to His disciples, *"The greatest among you will be your servant. For those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted."*

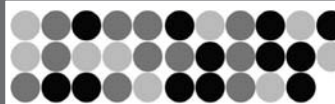
