## ***Society of Saint Vincent de Paul - Holy Name Conference mid year report 2017***

As this week we celebrated the **feast day of Saint Vincent de Paul on September 27**, the members of the Society of Saint Vincent de Paul–Holy Name Conference would like to take the opportunity to provide you with our mid year report and to thank all of you for your support.

In **2016**, through the generosity of the Holy Name parishioners and visitors, we collected **\$14,500** in donations, **\$8,600** of which were tax receipted donations (through regular and Christmas envelopes) and we had **\$5,900** in unreceipted donations collected mainly through poor box collections after mass on Saturdays and Sundays. This is a **\$4,000** increase over the amount collected in **2015** and our unreceipted donations more than doubled what was collected in **2015**. We put these funds to work by supporting our neighbours in need.

Throughout **2016** we visited more than **55** different homes and visited with, on **average 25** individuals or families per month bringing them food, vouchers from Pape Foodland for fresh food, and vouchers for clothing and furniture. At Christmas this past year we created over **93 Christmas hampers**, including hampers with gifts for **58** children. The number of our neighbours in need has also grown significantly in **2016**.

As at the **end of August, 2017**, we have collected **\$3,300** in donations and are averaging about **17** visits per month and have distributed over **\$6,100** in food vouchers.

We couldn't do this good work without the support of Holy Name Church, and you, its parishioners. The members of the Society of Saint Vincent de Paul – Holy Name Conference wish to thank you all for your ongoing generosity and support. We couldn't do what we do without you. If anyone has any questions or wants more information about what we do, we would be pleased to speak with you. Thank you.

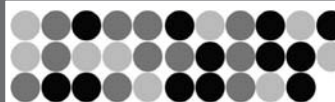
