SYNOD OF BISHOPS 2023

As you may be aware, Our Holy Father, Pope Francis, has convoked the XVI Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops, from October 2021 through October 2023. The Theme of the Synod is: For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, and Mission. For the first time, the meeting will be the culmination of a "three-year path" involving all of the People of God at every level of the Church. This "path" is a process rather than an event, which is meant to be a manifestation of "synodality" which is a form that realizes the participation of all the people of God in mission. The first phase is the "diocesan synodal phase" which will begin in October 2021 in all dioceses throughout the world. This first phase is described as "listening to one another and walking forward together, guided by the Holy

Spirit" (Vademecum, no. 4.1). The Synod then will proceed to a continental phase. This will involve the fruit of deliberations on each Continent. The final phase of the Synod will take place in October 2023 with the celebration of the Assembly of Bishops in Rome. We pray for the success of this unique and historic synodal process.
