Society of Saint Vincent de Paul - Holy Name Conference mid year report 2016



and Daily Readings

As we near the feast day of Saint Vincent de Paul, we would like to take the opportunity to provide you with our mid year report and to thank all of you for your support.

In 2015, through the generosity of the Holy Name parishioners and visitors, we earned \$10,500k in income, \$7900 of which were tax receipted donations (through regular and Christmas envelopes) and we had nearly \$2500 in unreceipted donations collected mainly through poor box collections after mass on Saturdays and Sundays. While the overall amount is similar to our 2014 receipts, the amount of non-receipted donations was up significantly. We put these funds to work by supporting our neighbours in need.

Throughout 2015 we visited more than 45 different homes and visited with, on average, 15 individuals or families per month bringing them food, Foodland vouchers for fresh food, and vouchers for clothing and furniture. At Christmas this past year we created over 75 Christmas hampers, including hampers with gifts for 29 families. As at the end of July, 2016, we have collected \$5100 in donations and we are averaging slightly more than 15 visits per month and have distributed over \$5300 in food vouchers.

We couldn't do this good work without the support of the church, and you, our benefactors. The members of the Society of Saint Vincent de Paul – Holy Name Conference wish to thank you all for your ongoing generosity and support. We couldn't do what we do without you. If anyone has any questions or wants more information about what we do, we would be pleased to speak with you. Thank you.
