- 3. For those who were baptized as Roman Catholics, but who have not received the Sacraments of Confirmation, the Eucharist or Reconciliation.
- 4. Those who wish to update his/her faith.

Attending our RCIA program does not imply that you are committed to joining our faith community.

It is our expectation that, as a result of participation in our RCIA program, you will come to a better understanding of our faith community and what is has to offer you in your spiritual journey. This may, or may not, lead to your wanting to join our community as a member of the Roman Catholic Church.
