Today the words of the gospel call us to look beyond our treasured possessions, obsessions and addictions for the sake of following Jesus without distraction.

“Whoever does not carry their cross and follow me cannot be my disciple.” cautions Jesus. Again, he warns, “So therefore, whoever of you does not give up all their possessions cannot become my disciple.”

Jesus is calling us to a deeper commitment, to look beyond people and possessions to a relationship with God. Jesus is calling us to understand the true meaning of “Come, follow me.” To be a disciple of Jesus Christ is an all-consuming vocation; it is never-ending.
