GOD AND THE SACRED LITURGY

What is the most profound origin of the liturgy?

The most profound origin of the liturgy is God, in whom there is an eternal, heavenly banquet of love—the joy of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. Because God is love, He would like to let us participate in the feast of His joy and to grant us His blessings.

THE CALL TO HOLINESS IN TODAY'S WORLD (REJOICE AND BE GLAD) - POPE FRANCIS

On Monday (April 9th) Pope Francis issued a exhortation to us all about the call to and the importance of holiness in our lives in today's world. Here is one very short extract from it:

"I like to contemplate the holiness present in the patience of God's people: in those parents who raise their children with immense love, in those men and women who work hard to support their families, in the sick, in elderly religious who never lose their smile. In their daily perseverance I see the holiness of the Church militant. Very often it is a holiness found in our next-door neighbours, those who, living in our midst, reflect God's presence. We might call them "the middle class of holiness".

THE IMPORTANCE OF EUCHARISTIC ADORATION

The importance of Eucharistic Adoration is shown in the fact that the Church has a ritual that regulates it: the Rite of Eucharistic Exposition and Benediction. This is an extension of the adoration of the Blessed Sacrament which occurs in every Mass: "Behold the Lamb of God, behold him who takes away the sins of the world. Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb." Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament flows from the sacrifice of the Mass and serves to deepen our hunger for Communion with Christ and the rest of the Church. The Rite concludes with the ordained minister blessing the faithful with the Blessed Sacrament.

What is the essence of every liturgy?

Liturgy is always the first place communion of fellowship with Jesus Christ. Jesus reveals his passage from death to life and celebrates it with us. The most important liturgy in the world was the Paschal liturgy that Jesus celebrated with his disciples in the Upper Room on the night before his death. For Jesus' death and Resurrection is the proof that someone can die and nevertheless gain life. This is the genuine substance of every Christian liturgy.
