A Marriage Preparation Course is required. If either party has been previously married, permission to proceed must be obtained from the Archdiocese of Toronto—Chancery Office.

- 8. The serious responsibility of international and local policy.
- 9. The throwaway culture and the proposal of a new lifestyle.
