JUNE IS THE MONTH OF THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS



Jesus knew us and loved us with a human heart.

His Heart, pierced for our salvation, is the symbol of that infinite love with which he loves the Father and each one of us.

ADORATION OF THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS

2669 The prayer of the Church venerates and honors the *Heart of Jesus* just as it invokes his most holy name. It adores the incarnate Word and his Heart which, out of love for men, he allowed to be pierced for our sins. Christian prayer loves to follow *the way of the cross* in the Savior's steps. The Stations from Praetorium to Golgotha and the tomb trace the way of Jesus, who by his holy Cross has redeemed the world.

THE LORD'S PRAYER—"OUR FATHER!"

2759 Jesus "was praying at a certain place, and when he ceased, one of his disciples said to him, 'Lord, teach us to pray, as John taught his disciples." (Luke 11:1) In response to this request the Lord entrusts to his disciples and to his Church the fundamental Christian Prayer. St. Luke presents a brief text of five petitions, while St. Matthew gives a more developed version of seven petitions. The liturgical tradition of the Church has retained St. Matthew's text:

Our Father who are in heaven,
hallowed be thy name.
Thy kingdom come.
Thy will be done on earth, as it is in heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread,
and forgive us our trespasses,
as we forgive those who trespass against us,
and lead us not into temptation,
but deliver us from evil.

2761 The Lord's Prayer "is truly the summary of the whole gospel." "Since the Lord... after handing over the practice of prayer, said elsewhere, 'Ask and you will receive,' and since everyone has petitions which are peculiar to his circumstances, the regular and appropriate prayer [the Lord's Prayer] is said first, as the foundation of further desires."

2763 All the Scriptures—the Law, the Prophets, and the Psalms—are fulfilled in Christ. The Gospel is this "Good News". Its first proclamation is summarized by St. Matthew in the Sermon on the Mount; the prayer to our Father is at the center of this proclamation. It is in this context that each petition bequeathed to us by the Lord is illuminated:

The Lord's prayer is the most perfect of prayers... In it we ask not only for all the things we rightly desire, but also in the sequence that they should be desired.
