BAPTISMS

Parents themselves should pick up and return a completed Baptism Information Form to the parish office at least 4 months in advance of the anticipated baptismal date. An interview with a parish priest or deacon is required. Parents of children to be baptized should be registered members of our Parish Community. Attendance at a Baptism Preparation Meeting is mandatory.

MARRIAGE

Couples themselves must contact the parish office at least **one full year in advance** of the anticipated marriage date. No date may be set before meeting with the priest. A Marriage Preparation Course is required. If either party has been previously married, permission to proceed must be obtained from the Chancery Office of the Archdiocese.

PRAY WITH THE SAINTS

WHAT IS INTERIOR PENANCE?

It is the movement of a “contrite heart” (*Psalms* 51:19) drawn by divine grace to respond to the merciful love of God. This entails sorrow for and abhorrence of sins committed, a firm purpose not to sin again in the future and trust in the help of God. It is nourished by hope in divine mercy.

(#300, Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church)

WHAT FORMS DOES PENANCE TAKE IN THE CHRISTIAN LIFE?

Penance can be expressed in many and various ways but above all in fasting, prayer, and almsgiving. These and many other forms of penance can be practiced in the daily life of a Christian, particularly during the time of Lent and on the penitential day of Friday.

(#301, Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church)

WHAT ARE THE ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS OF THE SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION?

The essential elements are two: the acts of the penitent who comes to repentance through the action of the Holy Spirit, and the absolution of the priest who in the same of Christ grants forgiveness and determines the ways of making satisfaction.

(#302, Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church)

WHAT ARE THE ACTS OF THE PENITENT?

The are: a careful *examination of conscience*; *contrition* (or repentance) which is perfect when it is motivated by love of God and imperfect if it rests on other motives and which includes the determination not to sin again; *confession*, which consists in the telling of one’s sins to the priests; and *satisfaction* or the carrying on of certain acts of penance which the confessor imposes upon the penitent to repair the damage caused by sin.
