A Marriage Preparation Course is required. If either party has been previously married, permission to proceed must be obtained from the Chancery Office of the Archdiocese.

What are the duties of parents towards their children?

Parents, in virtue of their participation in the fatherhood of God, have the first responsibility for the education of their children and they are the first heralds of the faith for them. They have the duty to love and respect their children as *persons* and as *children of God* and to provide, as far as possible, for their physical and spiritual needs. They should select for them a suitable school and help them with prudent counsel in their choice of their profession and state of life. In particular, they have the mission of educating their children in the Christian faith. (# 460, Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church)

How are parents to educate their children in the Christian faith?

Parents do this mainly by example, prayer, family catechesis and participation in the life of the Church. (# 461, Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church)

Who can educate us in prayer?

The Christian family is the first place of education in prayer. Daily family prayer is particularly recommended because it is the first witness to the life of prayer of the Church. Catechesis, prayer groups, and "spiritual direction" constitute a school of and a help to prayer. (# 565, Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church)


