#### "I Believe" — " We Believe"

26 We begin our profession of faith by saying: "I believe" or "We believe". Before expounding that Church's faith, as confessed in the Creed, celebrated in the liturgy, and lived in observance of God's commandments and in prayer, we must first ask what "to believe" means. Faith is man's response to God, who reveals himself and gives himself to man, at the same time bringing man a superabundant light as he searches for the ultimate meaning of his life. Thus we shall consider first that search, then the divine Revelation by which God comes to meet man and finally the response of faith.

- **47** The church teaches that the one true God, our Creator and Lord, can be known with certainty from his works, by the natural light of human reason.
- **48** We really can name God, starting from the manifold perfections of his creatures, which are likenesses of the infinitely perfect God, even if our limited language cannot exhaust the mystery.
- **49** "Without the Creator, the creature vanishes". This is the reason why believers know that the love of Christ urges them to bring the light of the living God to those who do not know him or who reject him.
