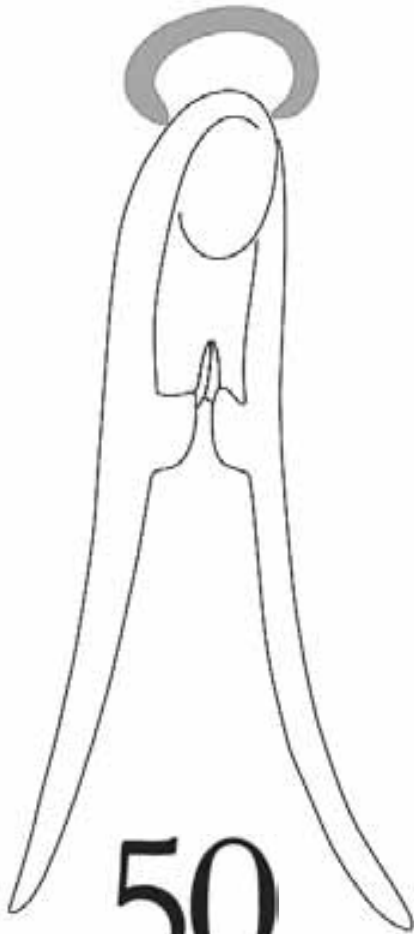

**BAPTISMS**

Parents themselves should pick up and return a completed Baptism Information Form to the parish office at least 4 months in advance of the anticipated baptismal date. An interview with a parish priest or deacon is required. Parents of children to be baptized should be registered members of our Parish Community. Attendance at a Baptism Preparation Meeting is mandatory.

**CARE of the SICK:** Visitation and/or Communion for the sick upon request.

**MARRIAGE**

Couples themselves must contact the parish office at least **one full year in advance** of the anticipated marriage date. No date may be set before meeting with the priest. A Marriage Preparation Course is required. If either party has been previously married, permission to proceed must be obtained from the Chancery Office of the Archdiocese.

### ROMAN MISSAL—THE NEW TRANSLATION WHEN AND HOW IT WILL BE INTRODUCED?

Parishes throughout the Archdiocese of Toronto will begin to use the new translation of the Roman Missal on the weekend of November 27. Joining us in this journey will be Catholics in all parishes throughout Canada and the United States. Beginning in September 2011, parishes in the Archdiocese of Toronto will begin to learn more about the new translation. You will notice many changes in the words that the celebrant (priest) uses when he celebrates Mass. There are also a few changes to the words that the congregation will use when they respond, also referred to as the “people’s parts”. We will also introduce new musical compositions as part of the sung Mass setting (Lord of Mercy, Gloria, Holy Holy, Lamb of God, etc.).

It will take some time to get used to these changes—please pray that we will all make most out of this opportunity to grow as a faith community. We will practice some of these changes before Mass, they may be discussed during the homily and we’ll use some other appropriate resources to help each other along the way.
