MARRIAGES:

Couples planning to be married must contact a priest well in advance of the wedding date. They must also receive personal preparation for entering marriage.

If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

PILGRIMAGE TO MARTYRS' SHRINE - August 6 - 11

This is a walking pilgrimage for youth, open to boys and girls going to grade 9 and older, supervised by Fr. Martin Hilbert and several adult helpers. **Meet at Holy Family for Mass on Monday, August 6 at 8:30 a.m.** Breakfast in the parish hall after Mass. We then drive to Colgan, Ontario, where we begin the walk, till we arrive at Midland on Friday, August 10. We stay overnight at Martyrs' Shrine and ride back to Toronto the afternoon of August 11. The total walking distance is 110 km, mostly along cycling & snowmobile trails and roads free of traffic. Sleeping accommodations will be in parish halls & tents on parish grounds - modesty and privacy being preserved between facilities for boys and girls.

What to Bring: Sleeping bag/blanket & pad; clothing (especially socks!); personal toiletries; water bottle; rosary; backpack; **good walking shoes; sun hat!**

What NOT to Bring: Electronic gadgets (cell/smart phones, games, MP3 players, etc.). The only exception is cameras.

Pilgrims will need to carry their belongings, at least part of the way, **so pack lightly.** Soap, shampoo, toothpaste, sunscreen, mosquito spray will be provided.

Cost: \$60/pilgrim (if cheques, payable to Fr. Martin Hilbert)
