MARRIAGES:

Couples planning to be married must contact a priest well in advance of the wedding date. They must also receive personal preparation for entering marriage.

If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

THE BEST WAY TO REGISTER IN THE PARISH is to take, fill in, and use the Offertory Envelopes, which are available at the Bookstall on Sundays, and at the rectory at other times.

When you need a letter of reference, for instance, to teach in a Catholic School, it is necessary that you be known by the Parish clergy for at least two years. Your offertory record gives us some indication of your presence in the parish, if a priest has not met you personally.

Using the Offertory envelopes makes it easier to issue a receipt for your donations at the end of the year, and enables us to keep our data base reasonably accurate.
