MARRIAGES:

Couples planning to be married must contact a priest well in advance of the wedding date. They must also receive personal preparation for entering marriage.

If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

When we begin using the new English translation of the Roman Missal on November 27, 2011, one of the biggest changes you'll notice is the words of the Gloria. When we say or sing it will not change – the Gloria is used on all Sundays of the year, except for those during Advent and Lent and a few other rare occasions. The text has changed enough that composers in Canada have written new musical settings for it. The Gloria is a joyful hymn of praise and honour to God. When we say it or sing it we honour God's importance. In the Gloria, we raise, with one voice, the song of the angels. IRAQI CHRISTIAN REFUGEE UPDATE

We now have a family assigned to us, which includes Melad Gorgees, 30, mother of two children; Stafia, age 13, and Stafro, age 10. Melad and her children left Iraq in 2003, fearing for their safety, due to the escalating sectarian violence and her extended family's employment assisting the US Army. They have been living in a Syrian refugee camp, waiting for sponsorship to Canada or the US. When protest and violence broke out earlier this year in Syria, the family moved to Jordan. Melad has been supporting her family by working odd jobs wherever she can.

We are told that they will probably not arrive until the fall of 2012. As their arrival date approaches, we will be asking parishioners to volunteer their time and material resources to help the family to settle.
