#### **MARRIAGES:**

Couples planning to be married must contact a priest well in advance of the wedding date. They must also receive personal preparation for entering marriage.

If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

#### **BLESSINGS AT COMMUNION**

# The Communion rite is a time to receive Our Lord in Holy Communion, not a time to come up to get

**blessings.** If you are not going to receive Communion, please do not come up to the Communion rail, but remain in prayer at your pew. Parents with young children should feel free to bring them to the rail with them. But please make sure to stop priests from inadvertently giving them their first Communion; and please do not ask for a blessing for them at this time.

#### COMMUNION AT THE USUS ANTIQUIOR LATIN MASSES

The traditional way of receiving Communion at these Masses is on the tongue and without the recipient's saying "Amen". (The priest says the whole formula, including the "Amen".) We encourage all to receive Communion in this manner, but, because we realize that some parishioners feel that receiving on the tongue is dangerous to their health, we may need a bit more time to return fully to the normal practice.

#### COMMUNION FOR THE HOUSEBOUND

The Fathers bring Communion to the housebound on the first and third Friday of each month. Please let us know if you or someone in your care would like us to visit. We are also aware that sometimes it is not practical for one of the priests to visit either because parishioners live very far away or because of various restrictions on who can visit the sick on account of their increased vulnerability to infection. In such cases, it makes sense for family members or friends to take Communion to them. If you know of someone in such a situation, please do not just show up with a pyx at Communion time. Please contact the pastor first. We will accommodate all reasonable requests, but we need to know about the situation ahead of time.


