MARRIAGES:

Couples planning to be married must contact a priest well in advance of the wedding date. They must also receive personal preparation for entering marriage.

If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

NEW AT THE BOOKSTALL

Darwin on Trial by Phillip E. Johnson

A convincing rebuttal of the theory of Darwinism and its materialistic presuppositions. If materialism is true, then Darwinism is as reasonable a theory as any other. BUT, if materialism is false, then Intelligent Design, and a Creator, are just as reasonable, and more so. Scientists have put the cart before the horse, and presume as scientific fact what really should be regarded as a yet unproved hypothesis. - **\$22 (limited quantity)**

The Didache Bible - \$55

This is an excellent new resource because of the way it uses the Catechism of the Catholic Church in the commentary sections. The commentaries are concise and theologically precise. The introductions to each book have scholarly considerations in mind, but are accessible to the average reader. There are helpful maps, useful apologetics pages for defending the Catholic faith, and excellent glossaries. This edition of the Scriptures was originally designed as a companion for high school religion courses, but will fill a much bigger need in the Church. Using the RSV translation, this edition of the Sacred Scriptures is designed for people of faith by people of faith. People will enjoy using it for studying and spiritual reading. I love my copy.
