If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

BILL 13 AND THE FREEDOM OF CATHOLIC EDUCATION Bill 13 ("An Act to amend the Education Act with respect to bullying and other matters") is scheduled for second reading (bills require a third reading before they may become law) when the Ontario legislature resumes Feb. 21st. This act includes the following objectionable amendment:

303.1 Every board shall support pupils who want to establish and lead, . . . activities or organizations that promote the awareness and understanding of, and respect for, people of all sexual orientations and gender identities, including organizations with the name gay-straight alliance or another name.

The Ontario Catholic Trustees in conjunction with our bishops have submitted to the government a document called Respecting Difference which shows how bullying can be addressed in the Catholic schools while maintaining our view of the human person and the family. 
