If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

SHHHHHH!!! PRIVACY RULES AT WORK

It used to be possible for a priest to walk into the hospital and ask to see patient lists in order to visit Catholics and give them the sacraments. Not any more, not even in a Catholic Hospital! Unless you indicate on admission to a hospital that you are a Catholic, a priest will not be notified, not even the official chaplain in the hospital.

IF YOU ARE TO BE ADMITTED FOR SURGERY...

Call your parish priest prior to your admission.
Upon admission at the hospital identify your religion
as Catholic. If you do not, no priest or deacon will be
informed, and thus will not be able to visit you.
Carry a card requesting the services of a priest so that
if you arrive at an Emergency room you can be cared
for spiritually. It is recommended that you have a
medical card that identifies your Power of Attorney.
