## **MARRIAGES:**

Couples planning to be married must contact a priest well in advance of the wedding date. They must also receive personal preparation for entering marriage.

If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

#### DESTINATION WEDDINGS

Catholics are reminded that they need their pastor's permission to enter into a valid marriage. Sacraments such as baptisms, confirmations, and marriage should as a rule be received in one's own parish. Sometimes, there are good reasons to receive them somewhere else and the Church makes provisions for such cases. In the case of marriage, at least one of the bride and groom needs to approach his or her pastor to obtain permission to get married in a church that is not the parish church of either party. Without this permission, the marriage is not valid. This is especially important to keep in mind at a time when "destination weddings" are becoming more common. Professional marriage planners often do not know of this Church requirement or do not worry about it for fear of losing business. They assure the couple that all will be taken care of in the Caribbean or the Philippines or Mexico or other parts of Canada. They may even know of an unscrupulous Catholic priest to do the wedding there. It may be convenient, but, unless the couple has the permission of their parish priest, such a wedding is not a valid marriage.

#### MARRIAGE PREPARATION

Our marriage course will begin on Monday, February 6, at 7:30 p.m. at Holy Family and run for seven consecutive Monday nights. Cost is \$100 per couple for parishioners and \$150 for those getting married elsewhere. No preregistration. Just show up at the first class a few minutes early. This is the only course through our parishes in 2012. Couples who are planning to get married are reminded to contact one of the priests as soon as possible.

### IRAQI CHRISTIAN REFUGEE UPDATE

We now have a family assigned to us, which includes Melad Gorgees, 30, mother of two children; Stafia, age 13, and Stafro, age 10. Melad and her children left Iraq in 2003, fearing for their safety, due to the escalating sectarian violence and her extended family's employment assisting the US Army. They have been living in a Syrian refugee camp, waiting for sponsorship to Canada or the US. When protest and violence broke out earlier this year in Syria, the family moved to Jordan. Melad has been supporting her family by working odd jobs wherever she can.

We are told that they will probably not arrive until the fall of 2012. As their arrival date approaches, we will be asking parishioners to volunteer their time and material resources to help the family to settle.
