MARRIAGES:

Couples planning to be married must contact a priest well in advance of the wedding date. They must also receive personal preparation for entering marriage.

If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

BLESSED SEBASTIAN VALFRÉ OF THE ORATORY -- JANUARY 31

Sung English Mass at 5:30 p.m.

Blessed Sebastian was born at Verduno at Piedmont in 1629. From his childhood he determined to become a priest, and was accepted by the Fathers of the Oratory at Turin, joining the congregation on St. Philip's Day in 1651. He received the priesthood a year later, and gave himself up unreservedly to

his priestly duties. In 1661 he was elected superior in spite of his own earnest remonstrances. His government was a perfect copy of that of St. Philip, enforcing exact observance in every detail, but showing great tenderness to the sick, for whom nothing was thought too good.

During all this time his fame as a director of souls was constantly growing. Like St. Philip, Blessed Sebastian was always cheerful. This was the more wonderful because we know of his own spiritual desolation and interior trials. His life was the model of a zealous pastor in a city where misery and evil abounded. He is described as dying of punctuality; for hurrying to evening prayer, he arrived overheated, prayed in a cool room, and caught a chill. He was 80.

In 1835, year after Sebastian was beatified, there was a solemn translation of his relics. Overshadowed at the time by royalty and ecclesiastical dignitaries, there were three future saints in the crowd: St. Joseph Cottolengo, who dedicated himself to the sick and destitute; St. Joseph Cafasso, who worked with prisoners; and St. John Bosco, whose work with children is known to the whole world. All of these could draw their spiritual lineage both by inspiration and imitation to Blessed Sebastian Valfré
