If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

THE THIRTY-THIRD ANNUAL

ORATORY THEOLOGY SUMMER SCHOOL

The Oratory Theology Summer School was instituted for lay people who are requesting both high quality catechetical instruction and a continuing intellectual formation in their Catholic faith.

July 10-14: The life, writings and legacy of Joseph Ratzinger, (Benedict XVI).

[Lectures at 8:30 a.m., 11:00 a.m., and 1:15 p.m; Mass; Lunch.It is recommended that students take the first session before taking the second but not required.]

The death of Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI inspired our second week of the summer school this year. We will dedicate that week to delving into Benedict's life, his many writings (both before and after his election), his complex papacy and the issues he had to face, as well as his personal interests. His life formed one of the last direct living links we had to the Second Vatican Council and to its authentic interpretation. He brought an intellectual and cultured presence to the papal throne, and despite his age, was able to accomplish many things.

The cost for the session, which includes lunch for the five days for those attending in person, will be \$200 per person. For those who would like to avoid traveling each day, simple accommodation is available on a limited basis in the Oratory's new Seminary Residence. The rooms are single, with shared bathrooms, and have access to simple cooking facilities and the Seminary Chapel (and the building is now air-conditioned—thank you, Renovatio!). The cost for a room is \$100 per person, per week, and participants are responsible for bringing their own bedding for a single bed. (Still one of the great bargains of the Western World.) The course will also be available online. Those enrolled in the course can attend live through Zoom, and recordings will be made available for one week after the completion of the course to allow those whose schedules won't allow them to attend live to watch the classes. For those attending only online, the cost for each session will be \$175.
