## **MARRIAGES:**

Couples planning to be married must contact a priest well in advance of the wedding date. They must also receive personal preparation for entering marriage.

If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

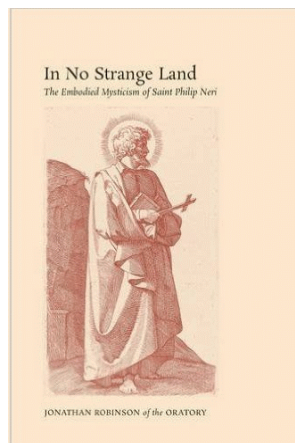
### WALKING PILGRIMAGE TO MARTYRS' SHRINE IN MIDLAND

July 21st is the date that the Confederation of the Congregations of the Oratory celebrates the 500th anniversary of the birth of St Philip Neri in Florence. All of the Masses on that day at Holy Family and St Vincent de Paul parishes will be Masses of St Philip. The relic of St Philip will be venerated after each Mass.

#### St. Michael's Cathedral Temporary Closure

St. Michael's Cathedral, mother church of the Archdiocese of Toronto, is temporarily closing its doors as part of its extensive restoration efforts that have been ongoing for the past three years. The next phase of restoration will require its closure full-time to allow for work that will preserve the cathedral for years to come. Daily Mass will continue to be celebrated in St. John's Chapel, a small worship space accessible from 200 Church Street. Nearby, St. Paul's Basilica will provide additional weekend Masses beginning in July, featuring music from St. Michael's Choir School to accommodate the cathedral closure. June 17, 2015 – mid-December 2015 - full closure of St. Michael's Cathedral.

Mid-December 2015 – January 2016 - cathedral will open briefly pre/post-Christmas.

January 2016 – March 2016 - full closure of St. Michael's Cathedral.

March 2016 – September 2016 - cathedral will open prior to Holy Week and Easter, remaining open while work continues through September 2016.

September 29, 2016 – goal to complete this phase of restoration. This date is also the Feast of St. Michael, patron saint of the Archdiocese of Toronto.

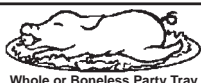
