## **MARRIAGES:**

Couples planning to be married must contact a priest well in advance of the wedding date. They must also receive personal preparation for entering marriage.

If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

**Please help to make our church a zone of silence for those who come to pray. Protracted talking within the church, even in whispers, can be a real distraction to those who are trying to focus on God. And when socializing after Mass, be mindful of closing the inner doors in the narthex and keeping the noise level down.**

**WE REMIND PARISHIONERS TO BE WARY** of their valuables (purses, back packs, wallets, muted cell-phones, etc.) while in church. Not everyone comes to church to pray! When you are going to receive Holy Communion, take your belongings with you. When you close your eyes in prayer, don't leave your purse on the pew, but use the strap to keep it secure. People can come up behind you, feign prayer, and make off with what is yours. If you see an attempt to steal something, please let a priest or Brother Ted know. There are enough temptations and opportunities for thieves; let's not make it easier for them

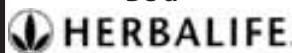
