MARRIAGES:

Couples planning to be married must contact a priest well in advance of the wedding date. They must also receive personal preparation for entering marriage.

If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

The mission diocese of Imphal, is situated in the extreme corner of Northeast India, comprising the entire state of Manipur. The diocese is home to 35 tribes of Mongolian origin, living in small villages perched on mountain tops. The first Catholic baptism in the diocese was recorded in 1952. The Catholic population has since grown to 97,000, with 50 parishes, and 160 priests including 65 indigenous tribal priests. **IMPLEMENTATION OF DECREE FOR INCLUSION OF
SAINT JOSEPH IN EUCHARISTIC PRAYERS II, III AND IV**
The Holy See on June 19, 2013, published the Decree
“*Paternas Vices*”, promulgated by the authority of Pope
Francis. The Decree stipulates that the “name of Saint Joseph,
Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary, is henceforth to be added
to Eucharistic Prayers II, III and IV, as they appear in the
third typical edition of the Roman Missal, after the name of
the Virgin Mary....” The wording to be used in English for
Eucharistic Prayers II, III and IV is “*with blessed Joseph, her
Spouse....*”

ALBERTA – FLOOD RELIEF

Floods in Calgary and the surrounding area have resulted in
tragic deaths and the displacement of more than 100,000
people, who had to evacuate their homes and businesses.
Thousands remain in shelters, while others have just started
returning to assess the damages. The archdiocese has been in
touch with the chancery staff of the Catholic Diocese of
Calgary – the Calgary chancery remains closed as a result of
the flooding, however, they are now able to accept
contributions to the diocesan relief efforts in Alberta. Calgary
Bishop Frederick Henry has indicated his intent to use any
charitable contributions to support victims in the areas who
need it most. On Tuesday (July 2) when power is restored and
normal operations can resume at the Calgary chancery,
Bishop Henry will convene a committee to assess the needs of
the greater community and establish further priorities.
