MARRIAGES:

Couples planning to be married must contact a priest well in advance of the wedding date. They must also receive personal preparation for entering marriage.

If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

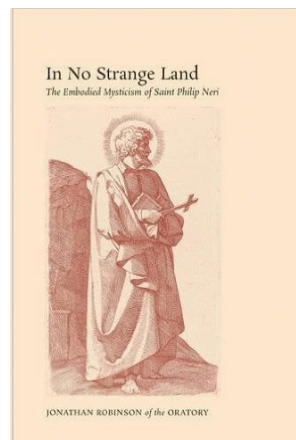

ST PHILIP NERI AT 500

July 21st is the date that the Confederation of the Congregations of the Oratory celebrates the 500th anniversary of the birth of St Philip Neri in Florence. All of the Masses on that day at St Vincent de Paul and Holy Family parishes will be Masses of St Philip. The relic of St Philip will be venerated after each Mass.

PLENARY INDULGENCE

FOR THE JUBILEE YEAR OF ST. PHILIP NERI

In celebration of the 500th anniversary of the birth of our Holy Father St Philip Neri (21st July 1515), Pope Francis has granted a Jubilee Year with an attached Plenary Indulgence, subject to the usual conditions (sacramental Confession, Holy Communion, and prayer for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff). During the Jubilee Year, which runs from 25th May 2015 to 26th May 2016, the indulgence can be gained every day in our church (and in any other church of a canonically established Congregation of the Oratory). To gain the indulgence, a pilgrimage must be made, or one should take part in a service or devotion in honour of St Philip, concluding by saying the Our Father and Creed and prayers to the Blessed Virgin Mary and St Philip. The indulgence may be applied to the faithful departed.

St. Michael's Cathedral Temporary Closure

A time line has been forecast as follows:

- June – mid-December 2015 - full closure of the Cathedral
- Mid-December 2015 – January 2016 - the Cathedral will open briefly pre/post-Christmas.
- January 2016 – March 2016 - full closure of the Cathedral.
- March 2016 – September 2016 - the Cathedral will open prior to Holy Week and Easter, remaining open while work continues through September 2016.
- September 29, 2016 – goal to complete this phase of restoration. This date is also the Feast of St. Michael, patron saint of the Archdiocese of Toronto.
