MARRIAGES:

Couples planning to be married must contact a priest well in advance of the wedding date. They must also receive personal preparation for entering marriage.

If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

AIR CONDITIONING UPDATE



As of Wednesday noon, both compressors have been delivered and put into place. We are now waiting for the manufacturer's representative to inspect the present piping from the cooling coil in the church basement to the compressors. If we hooked the system up without his signing off on it, the manufacturer would not honour the guarantee on the compressors. At

this point, provided that there are no more complications, we are hoping to have everything up and running by July 26. In the meantime, we are grateful to Tom Grydziuszek of High Park Heating for lending us some fans to keep the air circulating through the church.

For those who do not know, the system was vandalized by copper thieves in September. The thieves managed to get about \$100 of copper and caused \$54,000 damage in the process. Security has been increased with the installation of a camera that provides several days of records which can be given to police, should something happen in the future. We have also placed a sign saying that there is a security camera in place. Let us pray no one tries this again.

PILGRIMAGE TO MARTYRS' SHRINE - August 6 - 11

This is a walking pilgrimage for youth, open to boys and girls going to grade 9 and older, supervised by Fr. Martin Hilbert and several adult helpers. **Meet at Holy Family for Mass on Monday, August 6 at 8:30 a.m.** Breakfast in the parish hall after Mass. We then drive to Colgan, Ontario, where we begin the walk, till we arrive at Midland on Friday, August 10. We stay overnight at Martyrs' Shrine and ride back to Toronto the afternoon of August 11. The total walking distance is 110 km, mostly along cycling & snowmobile trails and roads free of traffic. Sleeping accommodations will be in parish halls & tents on parish grounds - modesty and privacy being preserved between facilities for boy and girls.

What to Bring: Sleeping bag/blanket & pad; clothing (especially socks!); personal toiletries; water bottle; rosary; backpack; **good walking shoes; sun hat!**

What NOT to Bring: Electronic gadgets (cell/smart phones, games, MP3 players, etc.). The only exception is cameras.

Pilgrims will need to carry their belongings, at least part of the way, **so pack lightly.** Soap, shampoo, toothpaste, sunscreen, mosquito spray will be provided.

Cost: \$60/pilgrim (if cheques, payable to Fr. Martin Hilbert) **Parents** can get in touch with pilgrims through the Oratory (416-532-2879). The receptionist will provide a cell number for contact.
