MARRIAGES:

Couples planning to be married must contact a priest well in advance of the wedding date. They must also receive personal preparation for entering marriage.

If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

'The Church and Non-Believers'

Our Lord's last words to his disciples were to go to all nations. The Church, from its very origins, was intended for all: it is Catholic, or universal.

But this universal mission has raised many issues for the Church. How do we proclaim Christ's truth to a non-believing world? How far should we accommodate the cultures and traditions of those we are evangelizing? How closely should we ally ourselves with secular authorities?

These are the questions that the great missionaries of the Church have answered, not merely in theory but in practice. This living tradition will provide a strong and faithful foundation for The New Evangelization the Church has encouraged.

Participants should have completed the First Session (Introductory Survey), either this year or previously.

Class begins at 8:30 a.m. Mass is at 10:00 a.m., followed by a coffee break. The second class is at 11:00 a.m., followed by lunch at 12:30 p.m. The final class of the day begins at 1:15 p.m. and finishes at 2:45 p.m. Application forms are available at the rectory.

PLANNING TO BE A CATHOLIC TEACHER?

It is critical for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic school board in Ontario, as part of your application for employment there must be a letter of reference from your pastor. If you (or if your adult child) is planning to apply to teach in a Catholic school, it is highly recommended you contact the pastor before Thanksgiving. Please plan to have a conversation with your pastor early in the process and you will avoid disappointment and stress at the time when applications are to be submitted.



ZONES OF SILENCE

"The search for intimacy with God involves the truly vital need of silence embracing the whole being, both for those who must find God in the midst of noise and confusion and for those who are dedicated to the contemplative life.
