MARRIAGES:

Couples planning to be married must contact a priest well in advance of the wedding date. They must also receive personal preparation for entering marriage.

If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

DON BOSCO AMONG US - RELIC TOUR

A relic of St. John Bosco is coming to Toronto October 5, 2010 - 7:30 a.m. - 11:30 p.m. His relic, contained in a life-sized statue, is on a six-year international pilgrimage in preparation for his 200th birthday in 2015. This relic tour is a reverse kind of pilgrimage where, instead of people going to the sanctuary to venerate the saint, the saint comes to the people. The relic tour is traveling through 130 countries where the Salesians continue their founder's mission. St. John Bosco was honored by Pope John Paul II with the title Friend and Teacher of youth. CAN I RECEIVE COMMUNION IN A PROTESTANT CHURCH?

Catholics are not allowed to receive communion in Protestant churches and communities. This is because of the requirement that Catholics receive Communion only in churches whose sacraments are valid, and only from a validly ordained member of the clergy.

While there are some instances where Catholics can receive communion in Orthodox churches, because their orders and sacraments are valid, for a Catholic to receive communion in a Protestant service would be to give the impression that there is no difference between their belief and Catholic belief in the Real Presence. Protestants do not believe that the bread and wine really become the Body and Blood of Christ through the action of the priest, but only symbolically or representationally.

We must all pray for Christian unity, and "have a burning desire to join in celebrating the one Eucharist of the Lord" as Pope John Paul put it. I suppose that this is like the burning (chaste) desire of an engaged couple to consummate their marriage: it is still true that only when they are truly one in body and soul through the Sacrament of Matrimony is it legitimate and holy to do so. Let us all pray *That All May Be One*.
