## **MARRIAGES:**

Couples planning to be married must contact a priest well in advance of the wedding date. They must also receive personal preparation for entering marriage.

If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

## ORATORY SUMMER SCHOOL

Since 1989, the Oratory has offered a summer school for lay people. There are two week-long sessions. The first week is an introduction to the Catechism of the Catholic Church. The topic for the second week varies each year. The first session is a prerequisite for enrolment in the second session.

There are three classes each day, taught by one of the Fathers of the Oratory. A special Mass is celebrated. And lunch is served. The day begins at 8:30 a.m. and ends at 3:00 p.m. The Oratory can accommodate a limited number of people in the seminary residence. The fee for the course is \$150 per session which includes lunch. The surcharge for rooms in the seminary residence is \$50 per week. Please note that the courses are aimed at adults and older teens.

Dates for Session 1: July 1-5; Session 2: July 8-12. The topic will be: *Essential Catholic Reading*. Application forms are available at the reception desk.

## IMPLEMENTATION OF DECREE FOR INCLUSION OF SAINT JOSEPH IN EUCHARISTIC PRAYERS II, III AND IV

The Holy See on June 19, 2013, published the Decree "*Paternas Vices*", promulgated by the authority of Pope Francis. The Decree stipulates that the "name of Saint Joseph, Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary, is henceforth to be added to Eucharistic Prayers II, III and IV, as they appear in the third typical edition of the Roman Missal, after the name of the Virgin Mary...." The wording to be used in English for Eucharistic Prayers II, III and IV is "*with blessed Joseph, her Spouse....*"
