MARRIAGES:

Couples planning to be married must contact a priest well in advance of the wedding date. They must also receive personal preparation for entering marriage.

If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

MUSIC AT THE ORATORY, NOVEMBER 2015

November 1, All Saints Day

11:00 - Solemn High Mass for All Saints & Fortieth Anniversary of the Founding of the Toronto Oratory

Fr. Robinson will be the celebrant. The Chant Schola will be joined by Norman Engel & Julia Wedman, Cornetto & Violin, respectively. In addition to playing some Buonamente, Lassus, Schmelzer & Marais, they will play an obligato line -- composed by our own Philip Fournier -- to the chanted ordinary of the Mass, with organ accompaniment. Philip chose Mass 2, Fons Bonitatis, for this project. Beginning by simply doubling the melody of the Kyrie, the instrumental line becomes gradually more sophisticated, as it is contrapuntally juxtaposed to the vocal line and the organ part, up through the Agnus.

November 2, All Souls Day

8:00 p.m. - Usus Antiquior Requiem Mass for All Souls: The Chant Schola will be joined by a 5-voice men's choir, who will sing some Palestrina and some Morales -- the best of both Requiems.

November 18, 8:00 p.m. Oratorium Sæculare: All Souls Continuing to explore Renaissance settings of the Requiem, we will do the Orlandus Lassus Requeim for 5 voices, with a sprinkling of music from the Office of the Dead. After the talk, given by one of the Fathers of the Oratory, sung Compline will include the first 5-voice setting of the Salve Regina by Victoria.

FOR THE JUBILEE YEAR OF ST. PHILIP NERI

In celebration of the 500th anniversary of the birth of our Holy Father St Philip Neri (21st July 1515), **Pope Francis has granted a Jubilee Year with an attached Plenary Indulgence**, subject to the usual conditions (sacramental Confession, Holy Communion, and prayer for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff). During the Jubilee Year, which runs from 25th May 2015 to 26th May 2016, the indulgence can be gained every day in our church (and in any other church of a canonically established Congregation of the Oratory). To gain the indulgence, a pilgrimage must be made, or one should take part in a service or devotion in honour of St Philip, concluding by saying the Our Father and Creed and prayers to the Blessed Virgin Mary and St Philip. **The indulgence may be applied to the faithful departed.**

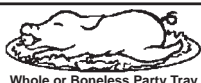
