If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

Blessed Salvio was born on December 22, 1877 in Santa Margarita de Vellors in the Diocese of Vic in Catalonia, Spain. He was ordained priest on September 19, 1903 and entered the Congregation of the Oratory of Vic four years1later. He was the Provost of the Vic Oratory when, in 1927, he was consecrated as bishop. He died a martyr's death when he was shot by Republican forces on the morning of August 5, 1936. We will honour this latest Oratorian Blessed this Wednesday, November 6 with a sung English Mass at 5:30 p.m.
