MARRIAGES:

Couples planning to be married must contact a priest well in advance of the wedding date. They must also receive personal preparation for entering marriage.

If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

SAINT JOHN HENRY NEWMAN

John Henry Cardinal Newman (1801-1890) is the best-known Oratorian in the English speaking world. Shortly after his conversion from Anglicanism to Catholicism in 1845, he brought the developed form of Oratorian life to England. At that time there were no Oratories in the English speaking world, and many Italian

Oratories were disappearing during the Risorgimento. Father Newman founded the Birmingham Oratory, and then sent Father Faber to London to found an Oratory there.

Pope Leo XIII elevated Newman to the rank of cardinal in 1879. He continued to live his Oratorian life in Birmingham until his death in 1890, when he died of pneumonia. John Henry Newman was beatified by Pope Benedict XVI on 19 September 2010 in Birmingham, England. **His feast is this Friday, October 9. The 5:30 Mass will be celebrated in his honour with music.**

Monday, October 5

St. Aloysius (Luigi) Scrosoppi of the Oratory

Born at Udine in 1804, he was brought up and trained by the Oratorians in the seminary of Udine and was ordained in 1827. He founded the Sisters of Providence, whose institutes work for the protection of youth, and with deaf-mutes. He joined the Oratory in Udine when it was legally reopened. He gave it the character of a real community and opposed its suppression, but without success. He participated in the initiatives of the Archdiocese, and became the servant of his brothers, in particular the poor. The Sisters of Providence, encouraged by his example, did prodigious good works among young girls, the sick and the aged. He died in his native city in 1884. **We will celebrate his feast on Monday, Oct. 5, in particular with an English Mass at 5:30 p.m., with music.**

Bible Study Has Resumed. We are thrilled to announce the resumption of our weekly Bible Study sessions on Tues. at 7:30 p.m. in the parish hall of Holy Family Church.

The format is simple. An opening prayer, a short recap of where we are in the book we are reading, then we READ the Bible, each participant reading a paragraph or two in turn. Comments & questions, and then we repeat the process. Our concluding prayer is one of the psalms, recited antiphonally, with a short reflection. We end at 9:00 p.m. Bring a bible (required), and a spouse, friend, or child (optional).

RCIA Classes

Weekly classes in the Catholic faith for adults have started up again. They are on Mondays at 7:30 p.m. in the parish hall of Holy Family Church. They are intended for inquirers, for those intending to be baptized or received into the Catholic Church, and also for Catholics who would like to grow as disciples of Jesus Christ through a deeper understanding of their faith.
