MARRIAGES:

Couples planning to be married must contact a priest well in advance of the wedding date. They must also receive personal preparation for entering marriage.

If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

EVENINGS AT THE ORATORY

Will resume on September 14th, beginning at 7:30 p.m. and ending with Compline at 9:00 p.m. . The topic will be:
“Memories of Madrid: World Youth Day Report”

The Oratory grew out of St. Philip’s efforts to spread the Gospel, through talks and music, to the people of Rome in the sixteenth century. Each afternoon, four talks were given, on prayer, the life of virtue, and on Church history. In between the talks, music lifted the souls of the listeners to God. These afternoon sessions, called the Secular Oratory, were well-attended by people of all backgrounds: from the most prominent cardinals, prelates, and nobility to the lowest servant. In 1575, when the Oratory first received papal recognition there were forty priests dedicate to this apostolate. Circumstances change. The pace of life today does not permit people to spend every afternoon or evening listening to talks. Nor can a smaller community of priests with other apostolates produce four serious talks every day. Nevertheless, we hope that the Evenings at the Oratory are a legitimate adaptation of Saint Philip’s work for our times. Presentation in the Parish Hall followed by refreshments concluded with Sung Compline in the Church.
