## **MARRIAGES:**

Couples planning to be married must contact a priest well in advance of the wedding date. They must also receive personal preparation for entering marriage.

If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

### LIFE CHAIN - SEPTEMBER 30TH

His Holiness, late Pope John Paul II in His Encyclical Letter  
" *The Gospel of Life* " said: " ...procured abortion is the  
deliberate and direct killing, by whatever means it is carried  
out, of a human being in the initial phase of his or her  
existence, extending from conception to birth" Many forget  
that the status quo in Canada is any abortion, at any time, for  
any reason, at taxpayer expense. Many don't realize that as a  
Catholic Christian we need to defend life and publicly  
oppose abortion. Mother Teresa said: "Any country that  
accepts abortion is not teaching its people to love but to use
