FROM THE PASTOR

Alleluia He fis It is so good to sing *Alleluia* again! He is Risen indeed! Alleluia!!! Remember what Pope St. John Paul II said, *"We are the Easter people and hallelujah is our song."* On behalf of the parish, I wish all of you a very *Happy and Blessed Easter!* Today is the most joyful part of our faith. Christ is Risen from the dead!
