22nd Sunday (August 30th) Get Behind Me Satan

What a drastic shift in tone! In last Sunday's Gospel, Matthew 16, 13-20, Jesus said "You are Peter and upon this Rock I will build my Church." Now, in today's Gospel, Matthew 16, 21-27, things turn quickly! Jesus calls Peter, Satan, and a stumbling block! After Jesus tells the disciples of his impending death, Peter wants to save Jesus from pain. You can't blame him for that! But there's more involved than just Peter's desire to protect the Messiah whom he loves. Peter should have known better! After all, he's following the Messiah, Jesus. Peter should remember how many prophets got rejected and killed in his religious tradition! Right now, even Peter himself, is being called to accept a prophetic role and it will cost. "If anyone wants to become my followers, let them deny themselves, take up their cross and follow me!" And following Jesus is not always easy! Christianity is not an easy walk, not all smiles and good feelings! There's a cross Jesus invites Peter and all of us to willingly take up each day. We are most likely not going to suffer crucifixion as Jesus did, but it's clear he invites us to make sacrifices for his sake and for the sake of the gospel. May Jesus see in each of us what he saw in Peter, a willingness to do the best we can to follow him, even unto death. Let us join Peter, and try our best on our journey of following Jesus to Jerusalem. And may we never be a "stumbling block" for the Gospel!!!

23rd Sunday (September 6th) Forgiveness

In today's Gospel Jesus addresses disagreements and sins between a brother or sister. And then he tells us that "whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven!" If someone has sinned against us, offended us, done us wrong, Jesus commands us to go and be reconciled privately with that person! Forgive each other. The time is NOW. Forgiveness and reconciliation is not something we should put off. We get one chance at life. As a priest, I have seen so many people going to the grave leaving their families behind in agony and hurt... not



only from grief... but from family disputes and turmoil! That's not what life is about! It's beautiful what Jesus says at the end of this Gospel, "Where two or three are gathered in my name, I am there among them." If we have a dispute with someone, take the time to sit down and talk it

out, knowing that God is right there in the thick of things. We must take that first step. Our God of love can help us through anything. It's actually un-Godly to let things fester for months and years. This is a "WAKE UP" call. Find happiness NOW... TODAY!!! Let Go and Let God! Who needs my hand in forgiveness... in reconciliation... this week? Who needs to hear me say, "I'm sorry," or "I was wrong," or "I forgive you... let's move on?" Let this be a week to bring peace and unity and Gospel love back into our lives and back into our families. Have a blessed and healing week!
