

Dear Friends.

We have begun the 2nd Week of Advent! The main Advent character, John the Baptist, appears in today's Gospel. John is in the wilderness, and goes to the region of the Jordan, where he prophetically announces the coming of the salvation of God.



John speaks of valleys being filled in; mountains and hills made low; paths made straight; rough ways made smooth! He preaches a baptism of *repentance* for the forgiveness of sins. Baptism itself is a purification ritual and what John does, is invite the people to be purified from anything unholy in their lives. Basically, let go of your old self. Prepare for the God who is coming among us, *Emmanuel*.

Two Thousand years later, we are also called to repentance, to change, to be transformed, and to be embraced by our ever-loving and faithful God. On that note, we will have our *Parish Advent Reconciliation* Service on Wednesday, December 16th at 7:00 pm.

Now, as for the world? What would John the Baptist see if he were to walk across the world today? What would he say? I'm sure he would condemn all those causing chaos in the world! He would see so many people who still need the valleys of hunger and thirst filled in; so many who need mountains of injustice and oppression made low; so many who still need a safe home to live, a safe school to attend; a safe environment in which to raise their children.

May we never underestimate what we can do as individuals and as a community to help spread the Gospel in the world. We have so many opportunities to serve, both locally and globally. It's amazing what we can do when we put our hands to the plough! There will be two families taken from the chaos of Lebanese Camps and brought safely to Niagara Falls, because of you. There will be over 150 little children with presents under their tree on Christmas morning, because of you! There will be so many who will have food for Christmas, because of you! That's putting flesh on the Gospel. That's what John the Baptist called for. That's what Jesus calls for. Let's continue to bring the Good News of God's Love through our Christian charity and stewardship! Come Lord Jesus! Have a blessed week!
